

## The Book of Jonah – Chapter 4

1. God's ministry to Jonah (4:1-11)
  - A. God hears Jonah (4:1-4)
    - a. Jonah became angry at God because God had compassion on Nineveh.
    - b. Jonah was concerned about his reputation.
  - B. God comforts Jonah. (4:5-8)
    - a. In Jonah's anger toward God, God was still his comforter.
    - b. Jonah was so angry and consumed with himself, he could not have God's heart for others.
  - C. God teaching Jonah (4:9-11)
    - a. In Jonah's mind, he had every right to be angry.
    - b. The book of Jonah ends with a question about God's compassion for Nineveh.
2. Some take aways:
  - A. God is full of compassion.
  - B. God wants to use us to show His love and compassion.
  - C. Even His enemies...God loves.
