One missionary writes of a question from her child: "Mom, can we put more Bible verses on the walls?"

She further states this was a most unusual request, especially since it came from her teenage son. So, she dug a little deeper to find out where this sudden interest was coming from. He said he liked seeing Bible verses on the walls of other people's homes, plus several Bible verses were becoming special to him. She said they started by simply posting more handwritten verses on the refrigerator, then shopped for wooden signs with verses painted on them. Rather than simply hanging random verses around the house, they chose verses that were truly meaningful to him and to their family. Deuteronomy 11:18-21, "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds, tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Write them on the door frames of your houses and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be many" This passage tells how God wanted His people to keep His Word always before themselves and their children. Instruction in righteousness is easier when children are familiar with the Word of God. Pray the children in your life, as well as the children of missionaries would joyfully accept the words of the Lord. These verses tell us, too, how important our Lord knows it is for us to ever have His words before us in order that we can be strong in our faith and spiritually fit to "contend for the faith" (Jude 3) in these days and the spiritual state of our nation. Pray, too, that missionaries would be enlightened with the creative opportunities God wants them to use to share His Word with the world.

In His presence...trust Him with your life.

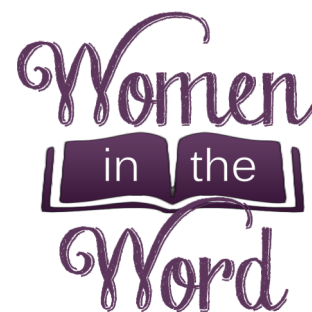

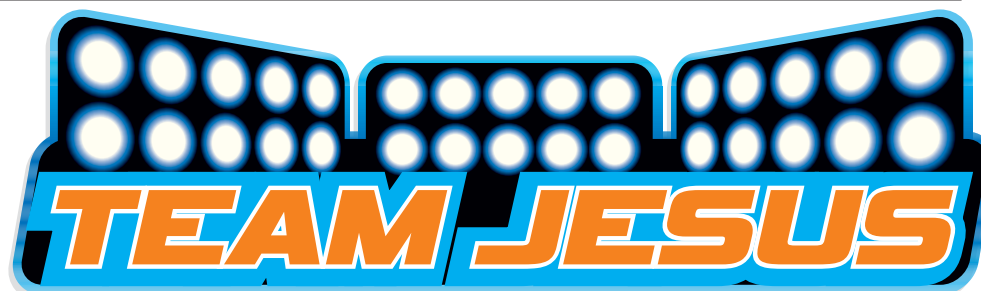
