Youth Building Offering and Pledge Cards

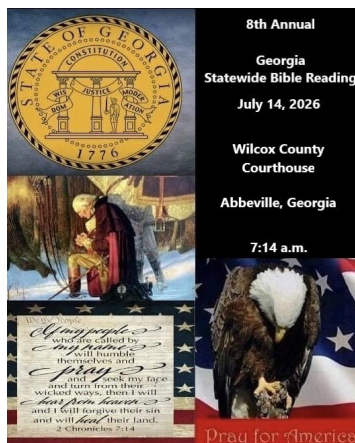
We are still raising funds for the Youth Building. If you have not pledged or given yet, please ask God to direct you in how He wants you to help.

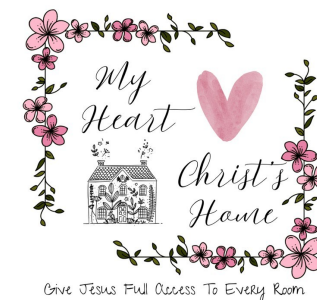
