WMU

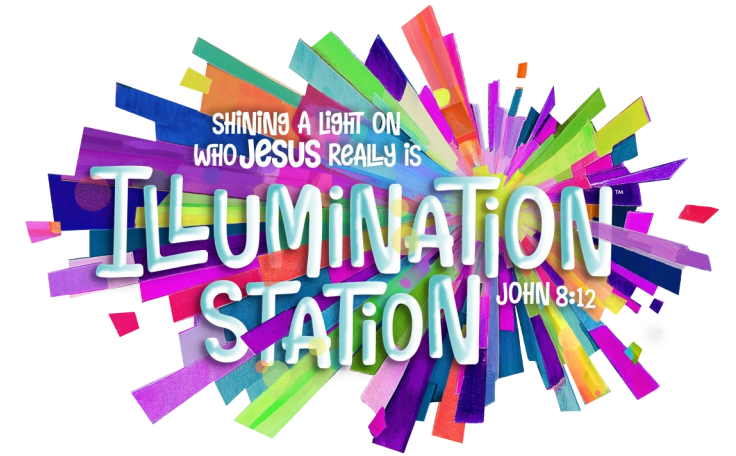
WMU will be held on Tuesday, May 19 at 7:00 p.m. at the home of Jena Rossman.

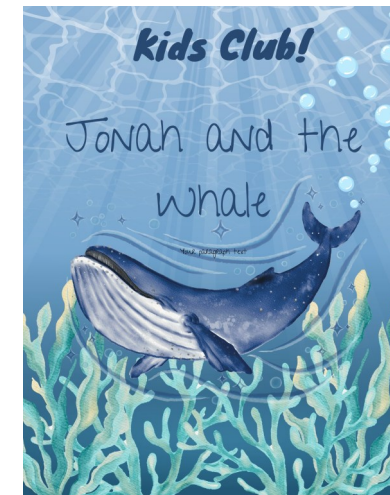
Youth House
