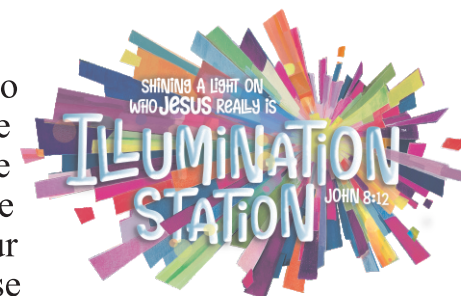

We read in Luke 5:5, 6a, & 7b "Master, we've worked hard all night & not caught anything. But, because you say so, I will let down the nets." "When they had done so, ... they filled both boats so full that they began to sink." Have you thought about fishermen are hard workers having to endure all kinds of weather-hot, cold, stormy, or windy. But, also patient and persistent all of which are good qualities for a disciple of Jesus!

In this Luke passage, Jesus called common fishermen to become His disciples, telling these seasoned fishermen that instead of catching fish, they would now catch people for Jesus. In Brother Richard's words we have been hearing on "Every Believer A Witness" series, Jesus called them to bring people into relationship with Him. They shared their time with the lost or backslidden to bring them into the kingdom of God. So, let's be like Peter and we might say Lord, I'm tired or fearful but because you say so, I will speak in your name looking to see how you will work through me. Work through me and other believers to bring people into a relationship with you.
